

7. Is college an option for me?

Your education goals are important! If you want to earn a college degree or certificate, there are ways to get there even if high school has been challenging or non-traditional.

What To Do

- If you are not in high school now, re-enroll and ask your counselor if you can take AP, IB or “dual credit courses” at JCTC or UL. You can earn college credit for passing the course or taking a test at the end of your high school class.
- Ask your counselor how to make up any content you may have missed. Let’s say you passed a class but just barely. To get into college, you may need to improve your grades. Your counselor can help you find the support you need.
